### CND 64<sup>th</sup> Reconvened Session

9<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> December 2021

As the Covid situation continues, OFAP can only attend the conference online.

When started, the chair of CND, Ambassador Dominika Krois, has played the video message from UNODC, saying that this year is another challenging year with all virtually arranged conference and remain in dialogue with governing bodies and NGOs.

China mentioned that they have been supporting the SDGs, especially in the number 10 where international cooperation is addressed. They also reiterated their position in the three international drug control conventions, such that they have already scheduled 188 new substances, in line with the principle of common and share responsibility, and adjusted the control of chemicals preventing their diversion into illegal channels. The Chinese Government also appreciated the efforts of INCB and WHO in strengthening the monitoring, assessment and scheduling of substances which help them in conducting the assessment scientifically, objectively, fairly and impartial manner. They are also aware the synthetic drug strategy 2021 to 2025, launched by UNODC, to be very significate for the synthetic drugs from angles of international cooperation, early warning or promoting public health responses.
